

Education Award Lakefield and District Horticultural Society

Part of the society's mandate includes spreading knowledge of horticulture, encouraging beautification and promoting the protection of the environment with sound horticultural practices. This award is to provide a one-time financial assistance to a graduating high school student or someone already enrolled in a post-secondary school horticultural/environmental related studies program.

Preference will be given to a student who lives in the Twp of Selwyn, Douro-Dummer, North Kawartha or Trent Lakes.

Procedure:

Each applicant must submit by July 31:

- Name, address, phone, e-mail, school contact info (see below)
- A one page, 300 word, typed, double spaced essay describing the student's interest in horticulture and career plans (point form is acceptable)
- Include a summary of any work and/or volunteer experience, etc. relating to their horticultural/environmental interests
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher/professor or a Lakefield and District Horticultural Society member
 Proof of acceptance into the post-secondary institution program
